Title: Medium Term Financial Strategy (MTFS) and Service Prioritisation

1.0 **SUMMARY**

1.1 The attached report at Appendix A presents to Budget Panel a review of the Medium Term Financial Strategy and proposals for preparing the 2011/2012 Revenue Estimates.

 September/ early October to Budget Panel and Cabinet.
