Title: Government Grant-Options for Change

1. SUMMARY

- 1.1. The Department for Communities and Local Government (DCLG) has produced a 408 page consultation paper upon options to change the current methodology underpinning the RSG Formula Grant redistribution process. These options are in addition to any general reductions to Formula Grant which will be announced as part of the Government's Comprehensive Spending review to be announced on 20th October 2010.
- 1.2 This Paper to Budget Panel provides a summary of the effects of potential proposed changes and indicates comments Watford should make to the DCLG by the closing date of 6th October.

4 IMPLICATIONS

These losses will be in addition to any general reductions arising out of the Governments Comprehensive Spending Review.
