As my Restaurant is well reputed in west Watford and areas nearby , we operate on whippendell road which is a quite high street in a residential area. We have never had a single problem in the last 4 years where we had to call the local police for any problem in our restuarant. To Promote the four objectives i have taken the steps to secure the place inside and outside with cctvs and fully alarmed system. For the Public my restuarant only opens till 11pm at night which aviods late night public nuisance. On our vast local customer demand we aim to provide food through home delivery service till 2 am as at present our home delivery service closes at 10pm and shop at 11pm.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

For the prevention of crime and disorder we have CCTV cameras fully integrated inside our restaurant and outside the building.. Our Shop alarm is connected with the local police.

c) Public safety

Again for Public safety we have cctv cameras inside and outside our premises. As we aim to do only home deliveries after 11 pm our staff is fully trained to deliver the food adequately.Public will not be attending the restaurant late night. We shall be taking orders over the phone not inside the shop after 11pm.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

In our case firstly the restaurant customer area will be shut at 11pm so we wont be having any late public nuisance taking place at our premises and secondly home delivery service is the best and quite way to deliver food at door step.

e) The protection of children from harm

We have alot of school students and children attending our restaurant in the day and afternoon time. As the we shall be closing the customer area at 11pm it will avoid children coming to our premises at late timings and we can provide them food through home delivery service which is quicker and safer.
