

## **WATFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL**

### **THE BOROUGH OF WATFORD (KING STREET, WATFORD) (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND WAITING EXCEPT TAXIS) (AMENDMENT) (No. 1) ORDER 2018**

#### **No. 843**

Watford Borough Council (“the Council”), pursuant to arrangements made under Section 19 of the Local Government Act 2000<sup>1</sup> and the Local Government (Arrangements for Discharge of Functions) (England) Regulations 2012<sup>2</sup> with the Hertfordshire County Council, and in exercise of the powers conferred on that County Council by sections 1 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>3</sup> (“the Act of 1984”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The Borough of Watford (King Street, Watford) (Prohibition of Stopping and Waiting Except Taxis) (Amendment) (No. 1) Order 2018 and shall come in to operation on 24 September 2018.
  2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
  3. The prohibitions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to, and not in derogation of, any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 by or under any other enactment.
  4. THE BOROUGH OF WATFORD (KING STREET, WATFORD) (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND WAITING EXCEPT TAXIS) ORDER 2018 (“the Order”) shall be amended in accordance with Articles 5, 6 and 7 below.
  5. A sealing date of 12 July 2018 shall be incorporated into the Order.
  6. Article 3 of the Order shall be amended to read. “Save as provided in Article 4, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle except a taxi to stop or wait during the hours specified in Column 4 of the Schedule to this Order in that length of King Street, Watford specified in the Schedule to this Order and identified as shown on plan 836/1.
  7. In Article 6 of the Order, the term “police officer on duty” shall be amended to read “Police Constable in Uniform”.
