| Reeds Crescent                          | <b>Sally Shires (Norbury Ave resident)</b> : Commuter ban being circumvented by employees at Weatherspoons. Obstructive parking  | Parking problems may escalate due to Radlett Road and Link road TRO schemes being considered in this area.              |
| Derwent Close/ Ennerdale Drive          | <b>Mr Adewunmi (resident)</b> : Jn. protection markings at jn with A405. Also more extensive issues re: obstruction/ access  | On-going concern and the location has been subject of a FOI request concerning parking and TROs                         |
| Lower High Street (adj to Bridge Place) | <b>Mayor's Office</b> : Possible shared use / residents' permit bay close to Bridge Place to protect approx 6 bays for residents/ short stay shoppers (Café)               | Originated for the Mayor's office.  |
