### 26. **COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP/APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE**

There were no apologies for absence.

### 27. **DISCLOSURES OF INTEREST**

There were no disclosures of interest.

### 28. **MINUTES**

The minutes of the meeting held on 27 October 2011 were submitted and signed.

### 29. MATTERS ARISING

There were no matters arising.

### 30. PETITIONS, TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS AND LOCAL ISSUES

The Panel received a report of the District Manager setting out the current status of petitions, information on any objections to Traffic Regulation Orders and other local issues.

### <u>Petition – First Avenue and Fourth Avenue</u>

The Chair, County Councillor Giles-Medhurst, invited Borough Councillor J Brown to present a petition she had received from local residents.

Borough Councillor Brown explained that the petition related to First Avenue and Fourth Avenue. Fourth Avenue was scheduled to be resurfaced in 2013/14 even though there were no potholes. First Avenue had more reported potholes but was not due to be resurfaced until 2017. The 21 signatories asked that the programme was altered and that First Avenue was resurfaced at the earlier date and Fourth Avenue later.

County Councillor Oaten advised that she supported the petition. First Avenue was a main thoroughfare compared to the other road, as it was a direct to a school.

Borough Councillor Johnson said that he agreed with the petition but the residents in Fourth Avenue should be consulted about the alteration to the programme.

Borough Councillor Brown replied that she had spoken to residents in Fourth Avenue and they were in agreement with the change. They acknowledged the state of the road in First Avenue.

The Chair asked that the Joint Member Panel noted the petition and that it was forwarded to the relevant officer who managed the Integrated Works Programme.

### RESOLVED -

that the petition be noted and forwarded to officers for action.

### <u>Petitions Received – St James Road</u>

County Councillor Bell thanked officers for the update regarding the petition for the introduction of a one-way route in St James Road.

The District Manager advised that officers were waiting for the results of the survey, which would be provided to the County Councillor. A report would be presented to the next Joint Member Panel for further discussion and consideration of any proposals.

Borough Councillor Dhindsa stated that he had witnessed arguments between drivers when they had met in the road and were unable to pass each other.

### RESOLVED -

that the position of the St James Road petition be noted.

### Objections to Traffic Regulation Orders

The Joint Member Panel was informed that at the previous meeting Members had agreed to support officers' recommendation to overrule the two objections to the Traffic Regulation Order for the prohibition of driving and cycling in The Parade when 'specialist' markets were held in that area. The Traffic Regulation Order had been completed and was ready for sealing. Members would be informed when it came into effect.

### RESOLVED -

that the update be noted.

### Local issues- Woodmere Avenue width restriction scheme

The Joint Member Panel noted that there had been fewer complaints about the Woodmere Avenue width restriction.

Borough Councillor Rackett asked whether the residents in Woodmere Avenue were happy with the situation.

County Councillor Oaten advised that she had not received any comments from residents for some time.

The Chair suggested that the situation should be monitored. He had discussed the issue with officers and it had been suggested that lines on the road could be introduced to enable vehicles to correctly line up with the restriction.

County Councillor Scudder said that he understood that the majority of accidents involved drivers coming from the A41 and approaching the restriction too fast and out of alignment. He considered the road markings to be a good option.

### RESOLVED -

that the Woodmere Avenue restriction continue to be monitored and consideration be given to the introduction of road markings.

### <u>Local issues- Radlett Road/ Eastfield Avenue Thames Water Flood Alleviation</u> Scheme

The District Manager reported that Thames Water prioritised areas where people were affected by flooding in their living accommodation. He said that it was important that residents contacted Thames Water if they experienced any flooding in their living accommodation. Thames Water was happy to advise residents on measures they could undertake to protect their property.

County Councillor Oaten commented that it was important that the Borough Council's Environmental officers needed to be involved in discussions.

### RESOLVED -

that the report be noted.

### 31. BRIEFING NOTES FROM NETWORK MANAGER

### Proposed National Grid Gas (NGG) Works in Watford – 2012/13

The Joint Member Panel was informed that there would be a presentation on 6 February when NGG would present the outline programme and traffic management proposals for the schemes.

RESOLVED -

that the report be noted.

### Use of Watford's Bus Lanes by Hackney Carriages

The Chair advised that many of the Transport Panel Members had not been aware that taxis were unable to use bus lanes. He suggested that option 5.1 ii should be the preferred choice but sought Members' views.

Borough Councillor J Brown thanked the Chair for ensuring this was reported to the Joint Member Panel. She had been trying for two years for people to consider this matter. Hackney carriages needed to be able to use bus lanes, particularly in Station Road.

County Councillor Brandon said that his concern with taxis using the bus lane in Station Road was the amount of space between the traffic lights. Generally there was the maximum space for two buses. He asked whether an increase in the space could be considered.

Borough Councillor Dhindsa agreed with Borough Councillor Brown's comments. He advised that drivers had approached him asking why they were unable to use bus lanes. This might encourage people to use taxis more. He welcomed the proposal to change the access arrangements at the Lower High Street. Hackney carriages near the Harlequin would be able to access it from the Lower High Street.

County Councillor Bell commented that when this suggestion had been raised on a previous occasion, a senior officer had advised that there were major legal problems. He was pleased that it appeared the situation had changed.

The Vice-Chair, Borough Councillor Wylie, stated that he had raised this matter when he had been Portfolio Holder responsible for Transport. The Passenger Transport Unit had refused the request and that the preference was for people to use buses. Taxis were a good alternative form of transport. He hoped that the proposal was agreed by the County's Panel.

Borough Councillor Dhindsa asked how the bus lanes would be monitored, as not all taxis were black and white. He asked whether permission would be given to allow private hire vehicles to use the bus lanes; they carried out the same role as hackney carriages.

The Chair replied that the report clearly specified that this would apply to hackney carriages.

The District Manager added that it was important to take one step at a time. The request had been for hackney carriages to be able to use bus lanes.

The Chair agreed that this was the approach that should be taken. He said that having heard the discussion it appeared that all Members were in favour of the second option. Both he and County Councillor Bell were members of the Transport Panel and they would ensure that the Joint Member Panel's opinion would be heard. He acknowledged the Member's comments about enforcement.

The Vice-Chair advised that enforcement was generally carried out by the use of cameras. It was important to arrange for hackney carriages to use the bus lanes and if that were a success it could be extended to private hire vehicles.

Borough Councillor Dhindsa commented that if it was necessary to change the signs at a later date it would cost more.

The Chair explained that the survey had been based on hackney carriages. If the scheme was extended to private hire vehicles at this stage it would delay the process.

### RESOLVED -

that the Panel prefers to allow taxis (hackney carriages) to use some or all bus lanes and 'bus only' junctions in Watford.

### 32. **SECTION 106 CONTRIBUTIONS**

The Panel received a report of the Area Highway Development Control Manager including the financial position and proposed uses for transport and highways Section 106 (S106) monies held by Hertfordshire County Council.

The Chair referred to paragraph 2.3 of the officer's report. He said that it appeared that the £250,000 released from the Croxley Rail Link funding had been fully allocated to schemes.

The Area Highway Development Control Manager informed the Panel that Appendix A explained the approved requests to use S106 monies in 2011/12.

The Area Highway Development Control Manager reminded the Panel that the Croxley Rail Link had received government funding approval in December. It was now necessary to ensure there was available funding for the required value for the scheme and that it was set aside. It was possible that other development sites may come forward nearer the scheme in the future. This could release some of the funding currently reserved for it which would make it available for other local schemes.

The Area Highway Development Control Manager reminded the Panel that £250,000 had been released from the ring-fenced funding in July 2011 and it was available for local schemes. At the last officer meeting, officers had identified schemes which had support from the Panel and were deliverable in

the required timescale. The proposals were set out in Appendix B to the report. This appendix also included details of new S106 obligations which had been ring-fenced for the Croxley Rail Link.

The Area Highway Development Control Manager added that Appendix C set out the current S106 contributions and the possible schemes that might be supported. The final part of the report set out the contributions which had been received from developers since the last meeting.

The Chair noted that the funding from two large developments in Leggatts and Nascot had been allocated to the Croxley Rail Link. In his opinion this did not provide for any funding to mitigate traffic issues in the local area arising from those developments. It appeared that there had been no consultation with Members to discuss where the £250,000 released funding should be allocated. He referred to the proposal to use £68,000 for Clarendon Road pedestrian improvements in 2013/14. Previously this was due to be paid for from the Local Sustainable Transport Fund (LSTF) budget.

The Area Highway Development Control Manager replied that it would be necessary to speak to the relevant officer regarding that particular scheme. LSTF was still at bid stage and was therefore not guaranteed.

The Chair said that the Area Highway Development Control Manager was responsible for the S106 budget. The Clarendon Road scheme did not need to use the S106 funds. This allocation should have been kept aside for schemes in Leggatts and Nascot.

The Chair added that the £250,000 would not have been available as it had been set aside for the Croxley Rail Link. Two of the schemes had been suggested by the Joint Member Panel; however, the first four schemes were new.

County Councillor Brandon said that he could suggest two alternatives in Leggatts Ward. He noted the £62,000 set aside for Old North Western Avenue and asked whether any designs were available. He had made suggestions and did not know the outcome.

The Chair replied that he understood this would cover the cost of new kerbing being installed on one corner. Further bids would be submitted.

Borough Councillor Sharpe stated that he was not entirely clear on the significance of Appendix B. He questioned whether this was a list of schemes officers had put forward for discussion by the Panel. He suggested that the Chair and Vice-Chair should consider the Panel's comments and then prioritise the order. The Panel had fought to get S106 funding for new local schemes. If a scheme were already funded from another source then it was not appropriate that it should be funded from the S106 budget. This would make the money available for local schemes.

County Councillor Watkin said that he was pleased to see that the crossing on Courtlands Drive had been included in the list. He asked whether the primary school expansion schemes would generate additional S106 funds.

The Area Highway Development Control Manager responded that those proposals did not generate additional S106 funds.

County Councillor Bell commented that Members had pushed for the £250,000 to ensure that areas away from the Croxley Rail Link were adequately funded.

Borough Councillor Johnson said that he had understood that it had been agreed that £111,000 from the Leggatts Campus development would fund the expansion of Old North Western Avenue. At previous meeting Members had specified schemes they would like supported and he understood that these had been agreed.

The Area Highway Development Control Manager informed the Panel that officers made the funding selection decision based on County Council and government criteria; taking into account strategic schemes, ensuring they matched the terms of each legal agreement and complied with legislation. He added that schemes close to North Western Avenue would be strong contenders for accessing the available funds.

County Councillor Brandon said that he was concerned that under the County Council procedure no schemes in Leggatts or Nascot would be eligible until local schemes could be considered for funding, as they were not usually strategic schemes.

The Chair asked whether the £101,000 from the S106 for Leggatts Campus had been taken into account in Appendix C. This showed that £226,832.10 was available for new schemes.

The Area Highway Development Control Manager advised that he was unsure but believed that the £101,000 was included in the available budget figure.

The Chair commented that this implied that there were no further funds available from the Leggatts Campus amount. The Panel had asked officers to process the Old North Western Avenue scheme.

The Area Highway Development Control Manager replied that he would take Members' comments and discuss them at the officer meeting and further suggestions would be made.

County Councillor Brandon asked that the situation was clarified as soon as possible.

County Councillor Scudder said that the improvements to the safety at the Dome roundabout affected three county divisions. The proposals should be brought forward.

The District Manager replied that this had been discussed at the officers' annual selection meeting. There were protocols which stated when funding could be made available in the capital programme. He had spoken to the relevant officer and it was hoped that the brief would be started before the end of the current financial year, if it was possible to identify funding for next financial year.

The Chair commented that schemes had specified their use for works at the Dome roundabout. He did not understand why the investigative work could not commence.

The Area Highway Development Control Manager replied that it would be necessary to discuss this with the relevant officer.

The Vice-Chair, Borough Councillor Wylie, stated that officers' responses were unsatisfactory. Officers did not appear to be clear whether the proposals in paragraph 3.1 of the report were included in the figures referred to in Appendix C. There was little Member involvement and therefore no democratic accountability. At Watford Borough Council if officers wanted to alter the capital programme a report was presented to Cabinet in the same financial year seeking the amendment. With regard to the current S106 report, he said that Members appeared to be the last ones to know what was happening. He added that the public expected Councillors to be in control. Compensation was sought for developments in areas to ameliorate the impact of the developments. It appeared that the procedure followed by the officers did not have any democratic accountability and it was not possible to intervene during the year. He stated that Councillors should make the final decision where money was spent.

Borough Councillor J Brown said that the S106 funds agreed for the Meriden Nursery School application and the Sun Chemicals site should not be used in another part of the town, but used in the immediate area to the application sites. She asked that Cow Lane was included in the review of the Dome roundabout. The Sun Chemicals application was a huge development site.

The Area Highway Development Control Manager advised that the District Manager would note the Councillor's wishes regarding Cow Lane.

The Chair said that officers had heard Members' comments and how they were unhappy. He commented that the report was difficult to follow. The report needed to be divided into the six county divisions. It was not clear whether the funding for the Croxley Rail Link had been set aside. With regard to Appendix B, he said that the first four schemes did not need the allocated amounts until it was known if the funding was available.

The Chair stated that there were traffic issues as a result of the Cow Lane development. County Councillor Oaten had discussed the matter with the Portfolio Holder. The funding was available for the required works and residents expected to see action. He added that Councillors were the people who received the complaints from residents.

The Chair suggested that the Joint Member Panel should not agree the proposals in Appendix B and that further clarification was sought.

Borough Councillor Sharpe added that there was a lack of Members' control. If the Joint Member Panel ceased to exist this type of scrutiny would no longer be able to take place. The two annual briefings would not be sufficient. It was important that Members were able to have this type of debate. He was concerned about the future and Members' ability to influence officers.

County Councillor Scudder commented that he agreed with the Chair's suggestion about Appendix B. Members should be able to put forward their own suggestions.

The Chair agreed that only the two schemes put forward by the District Manager should proceed, as these were the only two Level 3 local schemes requested by members. He asked officers to take on board Members' comments about the Dome roundabout and Old North Western Avenue.

County Councillor Watkin said that he was concerned about what would happen next and the apparent loss of democracy.

The Chair replied that there would be a loss of overview of the whole borough. The current report related to the whole of the borough whereas in the future he would only see the information relating to Central / Oxhey division.

The Chair added that where S106 funding had been acquired for specific areas that work should be carried out.

### RESOLVED -

- 1. that the Joint Member Panel's comments be noted.
- 2. that only the following schemes be funded with planning obligations previously ring-fenced for use on the Croxley Rail Link
  - Old North Western Avenue in 2012/13 (£62,000)
  - Courtlands Drive pedestrian crossing in 2013/14 (£23,000)

### 33. JMP DISCRETIONARY BUDGET AND LOCAL WORKS PROGRAMME

The Panel received a report of the Lead Assistant District Manager which provided information about local works programmes that were client managed by the Hertfordshire Highways Watford area team, including Discretionary Budget, approved Section 106 funds for local schemes and the Super CAT2 maintenance budget.

### <u>Discretionary Programme 2011/12</u>

The Lead Assistant District Manager reported that it had not been possible to carry out a deep clean in Cardiff Road. Officers had tried to carry out the works on two occasions but lorries constantly used the road. He updated Members on the schemes which still needed completion.

### RESOLVED -

that the report be noted.

### SuperCAT2 Works

The Lead Assistant District Manager reported that the majority of the schemes had been completed. Following a question from the Chair he advised that the works to resurface the roads would be carried out in March as officers were waiting for improved weather.

### RESOLVED -

that the report be noted.

### Highways Locality Budget Phase 1 Schemes 2012/13

The Lead Assistant District Manager reported that officers had received some costings and had spoken to the individual County Councillors.

### Highway Locality Budget 2012/13 – Cross Watford Issues

The Lead Assistant District Manager informed the Joint Member Panel that he would arrange meetings with each of the County Councillors to create a batch of lining work in their areas.

The Chair explained that this only related to non-statutory road markings as statutory markings would continue to be refreshed by the County Council. He asked that Members were provided with the definitions for statutory and non-statutory road markings.

With regard to Probationers, the Lead Assistant District Manager advised that they were used to carry out certain work. The Borough Council match-funded the amount provided by the County Council. It was recommended that each County Councillor should set aside £1,666 for this work. The work undertaken included painting subways and cutting hedges and growth at the base of trees. If Members agreed to the amount it would be transferred to the Borough Council who held the budget.

County Councillor Scudder said that it was important that the work was spread evenly across the area. He felt that this scheme was good value for money.

### RESOLVED -

- 1. that officers' request for batch lining be noted.
- 2. that £1,666 be set aside from each County Councillors' Highways Locality Budget for funding the works carried out by Probationers.

### 34. INTEGRATED WORKS PROGRAMME AND PROGRESS REPORTS

The Panel received a report of the Lead Assistant District Manager which summarised progress on the delivery of the Integrated Works Programme and other programmed works on the highways network in Watford.

### **Active Works List**

County Councillor Brandon asked why it was proposed that there would be a lane closure at the junction of St Albans Road and Bushey Mill Lane for four or five days.

The District Manager replied that in many cases the closure would not be required for the full period.

The Lead Assistant District Manager added that if the contractor did not met their deadline they would be fined for going beyond the end date.

The Vice-Chair suggested that the lane closure might be due to the need to divert pedestrians on to the road. It would be necessary to look at the plans for the scheme.

The Chair asked officers to confirm which part of North Western Avenue was due to be resurfaced. Where long roads were referred to it was not clear which sections were affected.

The Lead Assistant District Manager responded that this scheme referred to the section of road adjacent to the printers. The plan would be to do the anti-skid surface at the same time.

Following County Councillor Bell's question about the casualty reduction proposals for Wiggenhall Road, the Chair said that he understood the work to have been completed. He asked officers to inform him and County Councillor Bell of the works referred to by this scheme.

Following a further question from County Councillor Bell, the District Manager explained that the Whippendell Road and Hagden Lane signal refurbishment scheme would be carried out in the current year, but he could not give a precise date.

### **Integrated Transport Schemes**

The District Manager advised that he would check whether all the Automatic Number Plate Recognition cameras were operational.

County Councillor Brandon referred to the proposed 20 mph scheme for roads west of St Albans Road, including Victoria Road, Regent Street, Cecil Street and Judge Street.

The District Manager replied that these schemes had been brought forward as part of the locality budget. The locality budget would be used to fund the feasibility works and surveys. Once this work had been carried out a decision would be made on how to progress them further.

County Councillor Brandon commented that he had understood the schemes to have been funded. Officers had suggested the inclusion of roads west of Leavesden Road.

County Councillor Bell stated that he supported the 20 mph scheme for Park Avenue.

Borough Councillor Dhindsa added that the scheme had been discussed at a local residents' association meeting. Currently this was the only street not in the local 20 mph zone. At this point Borough Councillor Dhindsa stated that he should probably have declared an interest as he was a resident of Park Avenue. He asked whether residents would be consulted about the proposal.

The District Manager replied that a full consultation would be carried out. The Traffic Regulation Order needed to be completed.

County Councillor Watkin commented that part of the Park Avenue scheme was within his division and would appreciate it if officers consulted him as well as County Councillor Bell.

### Update on Watford Junction – National Station Improvement Project (NSIP)

The District Manager reported that the main work would be carried out between April and October 2012. Officers would have a clearer idea by the end of February.

County Councillor Scudder said that he was unclear about the drop off facility. This should be available to all users.

The District Manager explained that they were generally used by season ticket holders.

Borough Councillor Rackett was concerned about the pedestrian access to Penn Road. He said that the report did not refer to a pedestrian access. If pedestrians were able to gain access to this route they would use it. Previous discussions had referred to the access being the other side of Homebase. It would be necessary to add a pavement to this access.

The Vice-Chair commented that he could understand the time slippage, as there had been a number of design changes. Legal procedures could take a long time. He was pleased to see the access from Penn Road and pedestrian measures needed to be considered.

### Watford Borough Council Highways Works

The Transport and Infrastructure Section Head reported that further funding had been received for additional new style street signs, which would be extended to Queens Road Broadway. He advised that a parking consultation had been carried out in Oxhey. The Considerate Parking Scheme would be a pilot in the ward and could be introduced in other areas.

The Transport and Infrastructure Section Head informed the Joint Member Panel that new parking controls would be introduced in the Town Hall visitors' car park, commencing on 13 February. The parking rates would be the same as in the Town Hall and Avenue car parks. A 30 minutes free period had been

introduced. The flat rate of £1.50 would commence from 5.00 p.m. rather than 6.00 p.m. as at present.

The Vice-Chair noted that Lavinia Avenue had been called 'Lavinia Close'. He asked that this was corrected on future information. He thanked officers for the new parking scheme in Lavinia Avenue. He hoped that the severe problems experienced would be ameliorated.

Following a question from the Chair about the timing of the Shaftesbury Road proposals, the Transport and Infrastructure Section Head replied that there were a number of schemes in Central Ward and they had been put in order of priority. This particular scheme should be delivered by June or July. The refurbishment works would continue. He added that Traffic Regulation Orders could take up to eight months to complete.

The Chair stated that lines for the disabled bays located in Goodwood Parade were missing. He asked about enforcement action in the area.

The Transport and Infrastructure Section Head replied that he would ensure the lines were painted. He would refer the area for more enforcement action.

RESOLVED -

that the reports be noted.

### 35. OPERATIONAL PERFORMANCE OF HERTFORDSHIRE HIGHWAYS

The Panel received a report of the District Manager which advised on the performance of Hertfordshire Highways in the Borough of Watford.

The Vice-Chair noted that there had been a significant increase in footway trip repairs in comparison to previous months. In addition there had been a significant reduction in the number of street light repairs.

### PETITIONS, TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS & LOCAL ISSUES

Report of the District Manager

### 1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 The purpose of this report is to advise members of the current status of petitions, to advise members of any objections to traffic regulation orders and to inform the Panel of any other local issues of importance.

### 2. PETITIONS RECEIVED

2.1 No new petitions have been received.

### 3. PETITIONS UPDATE

### Petition – St. James Road One-Way

- 3.1 In Oct 2011 a petition was received from the residents of St James Road in the Vicarage Ward . The petition contained signatures from 112 residents who are requesting their road is made into a "one-way" street.
- 3.2 At the October 2011 Panel, members agreed to fund a survey of vehicle movements from Discretionary Budget, so that current levels of usage and direction of traffic flow can be established.
- 3.3 The volume survey carried out during week commencing 23<sup>rd</sup>
  November 2011 revealed a maximum daily flow of 534 vehicles in the direction of Cardiff Road, the one-way direction preferred by petitioners, with a daily flow of 71 vehicles in the opposite direction.
- 3.4 The on-street parking survey carried out on Wed 30 November 2011 showed of a total of 116 parked vehicles, only 6 were parked in the opposite direction to that preferred as the one-way direction, and these were located near the Cardiff Road end.
- 3.5 On the basis of these surveys, it appears most vehicle users are already moving in the preferred direction. It is therefore recommended to proceed to the next stage of outline design and informal consultation. It would be prudent to include the residents of Liverpool Road, Westbury Road, and Clifton Road in the informal consultation as some of the 71 vehicles moving in the opposite

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direction to the preferred one-way direction may choose to use these streets.

### Petition – First Avenue

- 3.6 In January 2012 a petition was received from the residents in First Avenue in the Tudor Ward. The petition contained signatures from 22 residents who are requesting their road is resurfaced before others in the area, particularly Fourth Avenue.
- 3.7 The central road maintenance team advised that whilst First Avenue had previously been in the Forward Works Programme, the latest countywide annual inspection had shown that many other roads in the county had deteriorated to a greater extent than First Avenue, hence it had been displaced off the FWP.
- 3.8 Fourth Avenue remains on the FWP for a thin surfacing treatment as it is a more cost effective treatment which will protect the road asset.
- 3.9 The treatment of First Avenue will be reassessed annually, and the next confirmation of schemes in the IWP / FWP will be available early April, and sent out to Panel Members soon after.

### 4. OBJECTIONS TO TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS

### WATFORD SPECIALIST MARKET REPORT – CONSIDERATION OF OBJECTIONS TO THE PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER – HIGH STREET, THE PARADE, WATFORD

- 4.1 Members agreed at the October 2011 Panel meeting to support overruling the two objections to the proposed Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) (Prohibition of Driving and Cycling on Market Days) associated with the holding of 'specialist' markets on that specified area of High Street, The Parade.
- 4.2 The Order was sealed on 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2012, and came into effect on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> February 2012.

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### 5 LOCAL ISSUES – update on National Grid Gas Works

- 5.1 National Grid have a substantial number of schemes in Watford during the coming year as part of their ongoing national mains replacement programme developed in conjunction with the Health and Safety Executive, to replace all metal mains with new plastic pipe within 30 metres of buildings.
- 5.2 Members were previously updated on the programme at a Special Meeting held on 6<sup>th</sup> February.
- 5.3 The latest programme is contained as Appendix A. The actual works start and end dates are dependent on weather and unforeseen ground conditions.

### 6. LOCAL ISSUES – update on use of Watford bus lanes by hackney carriage vehicles

6.1 In February 2012, the Highways and Transport Panel agreed to recommend authorisation of the making of an Experimental Traffic Regulation Order to permit hackney carriage vehicles to use bus lanes and selected bus only routes in Watford.

These routes are:

Station Road bus lane

St Albans Road bus lane - southbound between Penn Road / Bedford Road and Station Road

Lower High Street bus only route - from Lower High Street to High Street (across Exchange Road) - but not vice-versa.

- 6.2 The experiment only applies to hackney carriages and does not include private hire vehicles (mini-cabs) or any other bus lane or bus only route in Watford.
- 6.3 As part of the statutory TRO application process, consultation will commence shortly with affected user groups. Consultation will be carried out with County and District Councillors, police, fire and ambulance services, Watford Borough Council, the Passenger Transport Unit and cycle groups.
- 6.4 It is expected that the Experimental TRO will be made and come into effect in the summer. The experiment is expected to run for a maximum period of eighteen months, but can be withdrawn sooner. If the experiment is successful, a permanent Order may be made at the end of the experimental period to make the changes permanent.

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6.5 Traffic surveys will be carried out prior and during the experiment to monitor the effect of the changes. Objections can be received any time during the first six months of the experiment.

6.6 All necessary site works as part of the Order will be carried out just prior to the Experimental TRO coming into effect.

### 7. LOCAL ISSUES – major resurfacing of A412 St Albans Road

- 7.1 This road is due to be resurfaced from its junction with Longspring Road southwards to it's junction with Station Road. The resurfacing involves milling out and replacing the existing worn out carriageway to depths varying between 45mm and 70mm. The resurfacing will only be concentrated on the worst areas on the carriageway leaving out sections that are in good condition. There will also be some cracksealing and replacement of iron covers that are in poor condition.
- 7.2 Due to the nature of the works, the volume of traffic on the road and the potential impact of the works to the surrounding road network, it was agreed that the works be carried out at night between 7:30pm and 6am under a road closure. The installation of traffic management equipment will begin at 7pm. These working hours will give a long enough window to complete the noisiest part of the works by midnight and have a sizeable area to get the most work done and thus reduce the both the duration and cost of the works. This will also minimise the noise disruption to the local residents.
- 7.3 The closure will be carried out in 2 phases. Phase 1 to be from Longspring to Balmoral Road and Phase 2 from Balmoral Road to Station Road. The works will not necessarily be carried out in that order and it will be possible to work in both areas at the same time but only one phase will be closed at a time.
- 7.4 The diversion route during the closures will be via A41, A4008, A411, A412 and vice versa.
- 7.5 It is planned to hold a meeting with the Members to discuss the scheme with them in the next 2/3 weeks to address any concerns if any that they may have.

### 1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

### JMP DISCRETIONARY BUDGET AND LOCAL WORKS PROGRAMME

Report of the Lead Assistant District Manager

### 1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report provides information about local works programmes that are client managed by the Herts Highways Watford area team. This includes the Discretionary budget, approved section 106 funds for local schemes and the Super CAT2 maintenance budget. The report also provides an update on the local schemes as part of the forthcoming Highway Locality Budget for the 2012/13 year.

### 2. DISCRETIONARY BUDGET PROGRAMME

Discretionary Programme 2011/12

- 2.1 The list of suggested works for 2011/2012 year is contained in Appendix B. The list contains new suggestions put forward by members, plus schemes continuing and progressing from the previous year.
- 2.2 Scheme number 1 is a proposed scheme to improve the grass area outside 196–200 Leggatts Rise. Following a meeting in May with the County Member it has been proposed to upgrade the existing area of damaged verge with grass-crete blocks for vehicles and to install post and rail fencing to prevent vehicles overriding other areas of the verge. Members agreed to place the scheme on hold during 2010/11 and reconsider the proposals in 2011-12. Estimated cost is £13,000, of which the local member has agreed to fund £1000 from his locality budget. Works completed.
- 2.3 Scheme 2 is Phase 2 of the streetscape proposals in Buckingham Road which comprises construction of block paving. Estimated cost is £ 7,500. Works completed.
- 2.4 Scheme 3 is the Environmental Deep Cleaning Project jointly undertaken with the Borough Council comprising of 26 roads, of which eight are in the Sandringham Road area, four in the Watford Fields Area, seven in the West Watford area, and seven in the Nascot area. Estimated costs from the Discretionary budget are £25,000, topped up with £17,000 from CAT2 budget. Works completed with exception of some patching in Liverpool Road which is scheduled for first quarter of 2012. Completed.

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- 2.5 Scheme 4 is for completion of the schemes for Zones 2 (Smith Street area inside ring road) and Zone 3 (Elfrida Road area) of the 20mph Limits. Provision has been made for £200 of design fees to complete post site work activities. Completed
- 2.6 Scheme 5 is for completion of the Francis Road and Percy Road one-way scheme / 20 mph limit scheme. Provision has been made for £800 of design fees to complete post site work activities. "After" speed counts show 85percentile speeds are below 24mph, so both roads are suitable for 20mph limits. The local member has requested Market Street is brought into the 20 mph limit area speed survey to confirm if this is possible are ready to be ordered subject to Panel Agreement to £1000 additional expenditure for survey, consultation and TRO process under way.
- 2.7 Scheme 6 is Fairview Drive No Entry scheme. Site works are completed, apart from minor snagging works. Early observations show residents are coping with and complying with new layout. Completed
- 2.8 Scheme 7 is Dell Road and Elm Grove Traffic Management scheme.

  The Feasibility study is completed and informal consultation is underway on the recommended option. Members are not going ahead with the traffic management scheme but are considering yellow lines and junction improvements.
- 2.9 Scheme 8 is the 20mph Zone scheme for Cecil Street / Judge Street area. This is being funded as an IWP scheme under the speed management strategy. The feasibility study is now complete. Details of progress can be read in the IWP Progress Report, which is Item 10 Appendix C of the Agenda.
- 2.10 Scheme 9 is the A41 North Western Avenue VA signs. Details of the scheme are included as Appendix I. Fixed warning signs were installed in May. The speed and volume counts, repeated in Oct 2011, revealed speeds have not fallen. Hence S106 funding has been secured for design and installation of VA warning signs and coloured surfacing during 2012 which has been ordered, and expected to be installed in the summer.
- 2.11 Scheme 10 is for DDA compliant dropped kerbs for a disabled resident in Ebury Road to facilitate use of electric buggy. Works Cost estimated at £1300. Works completed.
- 2.12 Scheme 11 is for DDA compliant dropped kerbs for several locations in Chesham Way and Croxley View. Estimated works costs are £1500. Works completed.

2.13 Scheme 12 is for DDA compliant dropped kerbs at the Windsor Road / Sandringham Road junction. Estimated works costs are £1500. To be carried out during Deep Clean programme during Oct. Completed.

- 2.14 Scheme 13 is for construction of 3 to 4 parking bays outside Nos. 287/289 Sheepcote Lane. Estimated works costs are £8000. Job cancelled. replaced with Scheme 21. Abortive costs need to be found as contractor had already received delivery of "grasscrete" materials these have been kept to a minimum as the materials have been sold on to another contractor. Closed
- 2.15 Scheme 14 is for lighting enhancement of 18 No. footway luminaires between Water Lane and Shaftesbury Road (Phase 1 Estimated works cost £5400) has been installed. Phase 2, comprising 9 No. footway luminaires in the Reed Walk / Trinity Hall Close areas, estimated at £4700, including cost of Temporary TRO for footpath closures, is scheduled for March.
- 2.16 Scheme 15, promoted by Watford Borough, is for traffic and parking management measures in Greenbank Road in the vicinity of Holyrood School. The proposals comprise mainly waiting restrictions and school keep clear yellow markings, and it is also intended to convert the bus layby into a bus boarder. Estimated costs are £20000 works and £2500 design fees to cover safety auditing, design checks and health and safety risk assessment obligations under the Construction Design and Management Regulations. A meeting of key stakeholders agreed that consultation processes for the waiting restrictions and school keep clear yellow markings should be done before the bus boarder works. A scheme agreed by Safety Auditors and key stakeholders is currently out to consultation.
- 2.17 Scheme 16 is a safety or traffic calming scheme on Old North Western Avenue to reduce the impact of a substantial number of damage only accidents occurring on the bend near the junction with Courtlands Drive. The District Manager commissioned a feasibility study from his discretionary budget. Member and resident consultation has revealed a preference for a local traffic calming scheme. The District Manager has submitted a CS99 application for S106 funds from the Leggatts Campus development which has been sanctioned by the Officer Steering Group. Final approval for S106 funds takes place in the first quarter of 2012. Whilst awaiting funds for the traffic calming scheme, the Oct 2011 Panel agreed to allocated £3200 of Discretionary funding to install Treiff kerbing in place of the post and rail fence to prevent reoccurance of the property damage (Scheme 17). This has now been installed.
- 2.18 Scheme 18 is the pedestrian enhancements for the footway on Orphanage Road and Radlett Road under the railway bridges. An application for S106 funding has been made for the estimated works costs of £5000, which has been successful. Works are planned for March.

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- 2.19 Scheme 19 is the drainage investigations to reduce flooding and increase capacity of drainage network on Orphanage Road under the railway bridge. Estimate for these works is £20,000. Works were completed during October half term. The measures have been successful in preventing reoccurance of the flooding during recent heavy rainfall events in January.
- 2.20 The current estimate of fees and works costs totals £100,170 which is above the current confirmed budget of £100,000.
- 2.21 Members are asked to consider all the technical advice and reports provided and confirm a programme to the Lead Assistant District Manager.

### 3. SUPER CAT 2 WORK PROGRAMME – 2011/12

- 3.1 The Super CAT2 budget is an enhanced CAT2 budget used to support local highway maintenance initiatives and includes larger areas of work which fit in between the minor CAT 2 operational maintenance works and the larger scale IWP maintenance work programmes. Consideration has been given to maintenance issues in developing this work programme and the need to accord with the overall asset management principles of Herts Highways but with a degree of local flexibility and judgement.
- 3.2 Appendix C outlines the suggested Super Cat2 programme for 2011-12. Officers have identified 13 schemes across the Borough. These comprise carriageway surfacing works in Stratford Road, Whippendell Road, Church Road, Franklin Road, Greenbank Road, Wimbourne Grove, Chapel Close, Holland Gardens, Spring Gardens, Butterwick, footway surfacing works in Telford Close, and Structural Maintenance works to structures in Coates Way and Chalk Hill.
- 3.3 Please note the number of schemes which can be delivered is subject to available budgets. The costs estimates from the Works Team have come in below the budget allocated, so this has enabled another 4 suggested schemes to be added, which are footway surfacing schemes in Cuffley Avenue, Lansdown Close and Dell Road, and carriageway surfacing works in Windsor Road.
- 3.4 The footway scheme on Telford Close and carriageway surfacing schemes on Stratford Road, Whippendell Road, Church Road, Franklin Road, Greenbank Road, Wimbourne Grove, Chapel Close, Holland Gardens, Spring Gardens, Butterwick, and the retaining wall maintenance scheme in Coates Way, are now complete.
- 3.5 The Lead Assistant District Manager will be able to answer any queries regarding the programme.

### 4. HIGHWAYS LOCALITY BUDGET Phase 1 Schemes 2012/13

- 4.1 The list of schemes chosen by members for Phase 1 capital funded schemes i.e. medium sized footway and carriageway schemes is shown in Appendix D. The schemes have now been committed for delivery April October 2012.
- 4.2 This equates to 24 schemes totalling £329,000 as shown in table below

### APPENDIX D - UPDATE ON WATFORD JUNCTION--NATIONAL STATION IMPROVEMENT PROJECT (NSIP)

Progress Update provided by Andy Gipson, consultant to HCC Passenger Transport Unit

### 1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

In view of the importance of this scheme regular updates will now be provided to Members at Panel meetings. Since the last Panel meeting on 19<sup>th</sup> January 2012, confirmation has been received from Network Rail to allow London Midland (LM) to proceed with the scheme.

With the exception of the programme dates, the current status of NSIP has seen little change and is as follows:-

### 2. STATUS OF NSIP

### 2.1 Programme and Work On-Site

The main contractor is expected to be appointed by LM during March, 2012. The contractor will be J. Murphy and Sons Limited of Cannock, Staffordshire. The approximate timing of the works on-site is as follows:-May 2012--Start October 2012--Finish

### 2.2 Drop Off Facility

There has been no change since the last Panel meeting and HCC officers are in urgent talks with London Midland (LM) to request their decision on the the proposal to install 10 marked bays in the long-stay car near to the entrance of platforms 9 and 10.

This facility will be used by season ticket holders and passengers with a disability. Signage indicating this facility will be included in the schedule of new signs to be provided for the short-stay car park in Woodford Road (See 2.3 below). LM have indicated that the bays will reduce the total number of spaces in the existing car park and may affect a number of existing disabled parking bays. This would require a station change procedure because of railway legislation and an exemption to current standards may be required from the Department Department for Transport. If this happens some delay is inevitable,

An investigation into an alternative egress for private cars onto St. Albans Road continues with preliminary and full design work being undertaken by Hertfordshire Highways .Access and egress for the car park via Penn Road

is considered to be the best option. Penn Road is not public highway and agreement with the land owners and their tenants would be required. Discussions with the land owners are expected to be held during March, 2012.and if agreement can be reached, together with the appropriate funding, the scheme could be implemented during the financial year 2012/13.

LM would seek to enhance the scheme with the installation of automatic gates, ticket vending machine and CCTV controls at the entrance to platforms 9 and 10. LM is investigating the means of securing a funding contribution for this work from the Department for Transport.

2.3 Woodford Road

Network Rail made the Planning Application for the short-stay car park in Woodford Road on 7<sup>th</sup> March and approval was made by Watford Borough Council on 10<sup>th</sup> May, 2011.

The lease agreement between Hertfordshire County Council and Network Rail has been agreed, however Network Rail have still to legally sign off the document.

LM will install a ticket machine for the enforcement of the 20 minute time to park; no charges will be made.

LM will install a real time train arrivals/departures display for car park users. The proposal to review the bus stand and provide pay and display waiting in Woodford Road for approximately 9 vehicles has been approved in principle by Watford B.C., Hertfordshire Police and the bus operator affected Arriva. Hertfordshire Highways have completed consultation on the proposal which requires a Traffic Regulation Order. Panel Members should note that the majority of responses from residents in Woodford Road requested resident parking bays rather than pay and display waiting.

There has been a delay in advertising the TRO but this is expected soon. This proposal will be jointly funded between HCC and Watford B.C. and subject to the TRO being made would be implemented when the bus station work is completed. This is expected during September, 2012. It will not be possible to reduce the capacity of the bus stand in Woodford Road, whilst work in the bus station area is being undertaken.

### 2.4 Public Information

LM plan to post information at the station and on their website londonmidland.com during April 2012. Further consultation will be undertaken with major stakeholders such as taxi operators and groups representing the disabled. Additional information relating to bus stop allocations and services will be provided by HCC as part of the Intalink service. Members will be provided with this information in advance of the general public.

### 2.5 Bus Drivers Mess Room

No change since the last panel meeting. LM has agreed to provide this facility for bus drivers. Currently a parked bus is used by Arriva staff. A licence agreement to agree the level and maintenance of the facility is required between LM and Arriva. Discussions on this agreement are still outstanding.

### 2.6 Platform 11 (Abbey Line)

No change since the last panel meeting.

The installation and associated costs of the heated waiting room for Platform 11 has been agreed. The build and installation of the waiting room is expected before the end of March, 2012.

### 3. FURTHER INFORMATION

If further information becomes available from London Midland this will be reported orally at the meeting.

### APPENDIX E - WATFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL HIGHWAY WORKS

### A) Highway related

Under s115 of the Highways Act

The Borough Council can undertake works on the highway where they are providing an amenity.

### 1) Town Centre Cultural Study – Rickmansworth Rd to Albert Rd Sth

The Council has appointed Building Design Partnership to provide consultancy services for the feasibility, design and supervision of the public realm works. This element will develop the concept design in the Town Centre Cultural Study for public consultation in Spring 2012. Site surveys are currently underway.

### B) Transport related projects on Council owned land

### 1) Oxhey Park pedestrian and cycle bridge

a) Following completion of the bridge additional works to upgrade the path and install direction signage on part of fp56 and the permissive path from the bridge to Lower High St will be complete by mid April 2012.

### 2) Whippendell Woods Bridleway conversion

a) The existing Council owned permissive horse track has been upgraded to adoptable standard and access improvements made at the Rousebarn Lane and Grove Mill Lane entrances. HCC are in the process of finalising legal orders to adopt it as a Bridleway thus permitting cycling on it. HCC have not given a completion date.

### C) RIGHTS OF WAY WORKS BY THE LOCAL PLANNING AUTHORITY

The Council is required to carry out footpath diversions under the s.257 Town and County Planning Act 1990 to enable developments to take place.

### 1) Watford Springs site FP50 and 52

Planning consent was granted in August 2009 and the development necessitates the diversion of definitive footpaths 50 and 52. Preparation of draft legal orders is being completed by HCC Rights of Way unit. It is anticipated that they will be published for consultation in April 2012. A temporary diversion for the duration of the works will be in place for the duration of construction works.

A Creation Order under s.25 for the dedication of an additional width of path leading to Watford Fields infant school will also be made by Watford Council.

### 2) Oxhey Park Bridge FP56

The siting of the bridge necessitates the permanent diversion of 60m of definitive footpath on the east bank of the river. Informal consultation has taken place with The Ramblers Association and draft legal orders are expected to be published in May 2012 (subject to HCC rights of way approval).

### **D** Planning and Development

### **New Style Street Name Plates**

Following the introduction of the new style street name plates as part of phase 1 of the County Council led Clarendon Road Pedestrian Improvements Programme, a further 50 new style plates with destination sub-plates are being introduced throughout the town. In addition to the name plates already installed in the Central ward the new name plates will be appearing in Oxhey, Tudor, Park, Vicarage and Woodside over the next month. The plates will provide average walking time to key pedestrian destinations. The scheme aims to combine information on one single sign and de-cluttering old signage.

### **Parking Service**

### **New Parking Machine Project**

The new parking machine upgrade project has been completed with the final 12 machines installed last month. The new machines will cater for the new style 5p and 10p coins which are being introduced in March/April. They will also provide added security and user reliability.

The parking service has been working towards producing new GIS (Geographic Information Systems) maps which will be available to the public on-line. The maps will show where 1, 2 and 4hour pay and display parking are located in the Borough and the boundaries of the controlled parking zones.

### **Traffic Regulation Orders**

### **Cassiobury Controlled Parking Zone Review**

Revised proposals for the detailed design of the parking arrangements for the 8 additional roads proposed for inclusion in the zone have been developed in light of objections received to the statutory process run at the end of 2011. The revised proposals will be advertised formally inviting objection at the end of March 2012.

The informal consultation on proposals to manage parking in the vicinity of the shops at the Langley Way/ Cassiobury Drive junction is on-going and a preferred scheme is to be submitted to Hertfordshire Highways for comment

during March. Improvements to the facilities for pedestrians at this junction are being incorporated in to the design with a view to bringing forward a more detailed proposal for wider consultation later in 2012.

### **Nascot Area**

A revised scheme parking controls in Bellamy Close, Grandfield Ave, Langwood Gardens and Maple Grove have been prepared taking account of comments received through the public consultation held in November 2011. Formal Statutory Consultation the revised scheme is proposed for May 2012. Further consultation on parking and other traffic related issues in The Avenue, Church Road area and Park Road is planned for later in 2012.

### Oxhey Ward parking Consultation

A Ward wide consultation with residents and businesses in relation to parking issues took place during July and August indicated that residents did not support area wide parking controls to address parking issues. Measures to adjust existing yellow line restrictions at junctions within the Ward, including the introduction of some short stay parking to support local shops and some new parking controls on junctions where obstructive parking has been a problem have being developed in conjunction with Ward Members and OVEG. These proposals are currently out to informal consultation with the Police, Herts Highways and the Council's Waste Services Team with a view to commencing the Statutory Consultation later in the year. The Council and Hertfordshire Highways are also supporting OVEG in the development of a community led Considerate Parking Scheme aimed at encouraging responsible parking attitudes within the Ward.

### **Queens Road/ The Broadway**

Proposals to introduce a small number of free limited waiting spaces in Queens Road to support top up shopping habits are to be taken to Statutory Consultation during the early part of 2012 along with a number of other small amendments to current parking controls in the existing CPZs. Changes to parking controls in Queens Road to extend the length of time motorcycles can be parked free of charge in the designated motorcycle bay from 1 hour to 2 hours is included in the proposed changes. Subject to the satisfactory resolution of any objections received it is expected that the changes will be implemented during the Summer.

### **Shaftesbury Road – Waterfields Recreation Ground car park**

Proposals to manage the car park at the end of Shaftesbury Road to protect parking opportunity for residents permit holders and short term visitors to Waterfields Recreation Ground are also due to go to Statutory Consultation as part of the same process referred to above.

### **Various Road Traffic Orders**

Work on the next 'various roads' Order covering between 15 and 20 sites across the Borough has commenced. Ward/ Divisional Members will be contacted with initial proposals for their initial comments in the next two months. It is anticipated that it will take up to the end of the summer 2012 to complete this Order.
