The shop would open at 6am for the sale of newspapers etc, and the alcohol sales would continue to start from 8am, as it does at the minute. We just want to develop the business and offer customers a better service.

The law requires licensed premises to promote the 4 licensing objectives which are; the prevention of crime and disorder, public safety, prevention of public nuisance and the protection of children from harm. The licence is subject to a number of conditions including CCTV, staff training on preventing underage sales, etc.

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

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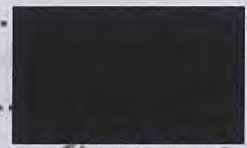

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
