Waste Collection Policy

Watford Borough Council (the Council) acknowledges the issues caused by excess waste, waste presented for collection not being contained wholly within the bin, bins and recycling boxes being left on the highway permanently, and non-household waste presented for collection. In order to address these issues the Council confirms that:

1. It will not collect excess waste (defined as waste not wholly contained within the bin when the lid is shut flat and/or more than 3 black sacks per household presented for collection)
2. It will not empty bins placed for collection where the lid is not fully closed by virtue of overfilling (with waste / items for recycling / composting etc) – please note that additional recycling will be collected if presented correctly.
3. It will require households to keep all their bins (waste, recycling and organic) within the curtilage of their property except when presented for collection on the allocated collection day
4. It will not remove non-household waste presented for collection unless previously agreed with the Council.

And the Council will use relevant legal notices to achieve this policy.
