

Peter Andrew Squires

Upon entering the P.S. (on Rd), I immediately identified a group of about 8 males. One of whom I now know to be Neil WACKER. WACKER was at the bar and had ordered and been served with alcoholic drinks. WACKER was talking loudly to his mates in a broad midlands accent. WACKER and others in his group had tattoo's on their arms of Native folk (club faces and such) identifiable as Native folk.

I immediately spoke to WACKER and the group and identified myself as a NOTTINGHAMshire Police Officer. I informed them that they were in a house for only public houses. They replied that the door staff had let them in without asking them or checking who they supported. They also added that they had all bought drinks with no problems and that there was no sign on the door or on the pub stating it was a home for only pub.

The group were approached by the landlord of the public house and asked to leave. The group were social minded and quickly finished their drinks and left. They apologised saying they didn't know they had been in (the man) pub. It is of my opinion that this group would have been clearly identifiable as Nottingham folk. And to door and bar staff at the P.S. (on Rd) the house. Whilst no disorder occurred on this occasion this group presence could have been enough to spark an anti-social chance or public disorder. This statement is made at 1455 hrs the same day as my original note and should be referred to as such.
