Public Nuisance:

There is considerable noise, not just noise from within the Nascot Arms, but also from the smokers and mobile phone users who congregate outside on the pavement. The pavement is narrow and regularly blocked with Nascot Arms customers spilling out to smoke or use their mobile phones whilst continuing to consume their drinks. This also adds to the litter around the area. On warmer evenings many customers stand outside and this was encouraged last year when chairs and tables were placed on the pavements around the Nascot Arms.

There is additional noise and disturbance as Taxis arrive and block the street while waiting for their clients to leave.

Customers regularly park their cars on the double yellow lines around the corners of the Nascot Place / Stamford Road junction making it very difficult for residents to get in and out of Nascot Place.

All of this activity, late into the night / early morning, is unsuited to a quite residential area - making it noisy, dirty and unpleasant.
